The following points were recorded during analysis of the student's feedback:

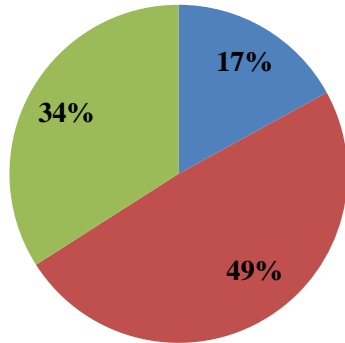
- The student's feedback revealed that, more than 90% of students know the objectives of their subject

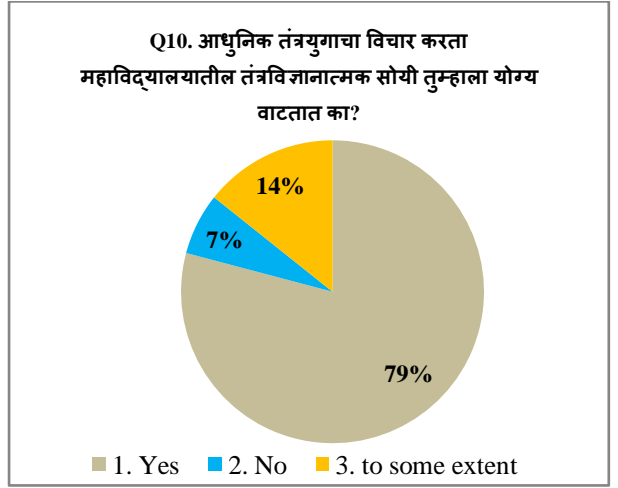
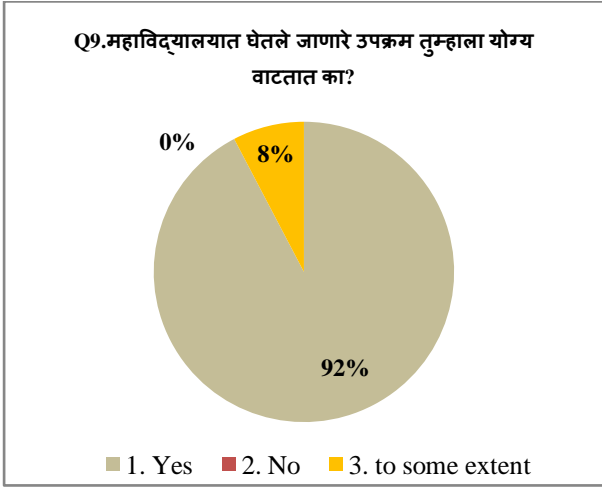
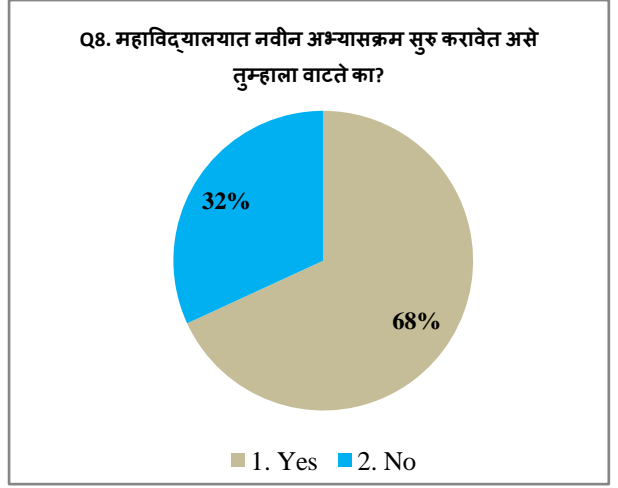
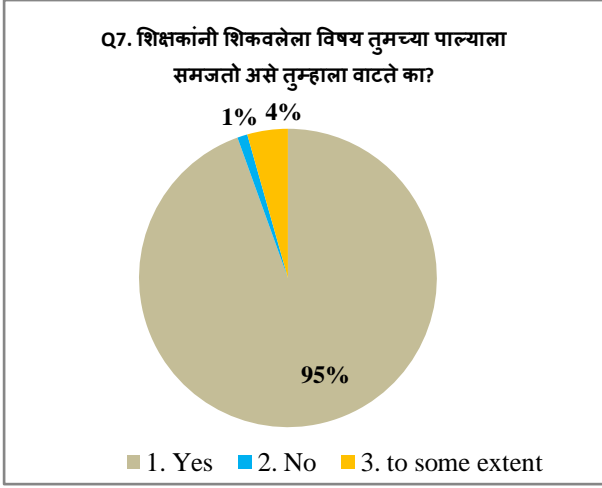
The following points were recorded during analysis of the Parents feedback:

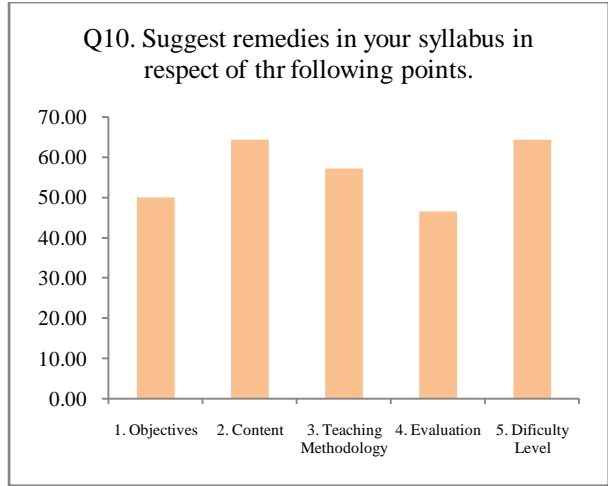
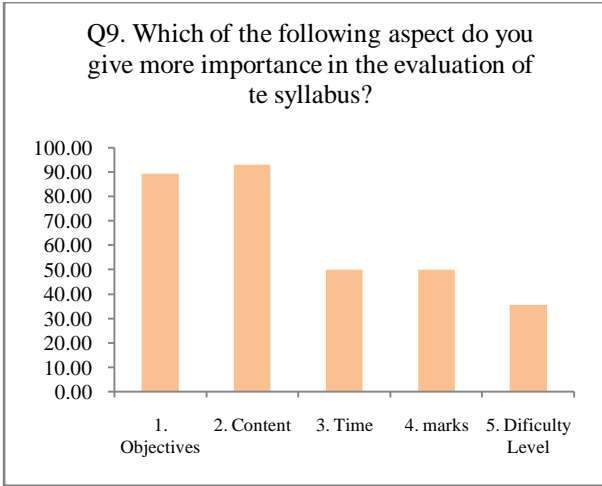
The feedback taken from teachers about the present syllabus and curriculum of the institute reveals the following facts:

The feedback taken from alumni about the institution and curriculum reveals the following facts:

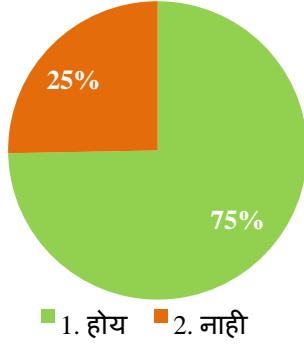
- The feedback analysis of alumni revealed that, the new courses should be started along with the present programs.
