After the completion of mushroom inoculation he gave few tips to avoid common mistakes happened during mushroom cultivation. Mushrooms are ready to harvest when the caps are fully formed and the veil underneath the cap has broken. It is important to harvest the mushrooms at the right time to prevent them from becoming too mature or over-ripe. She told, a proper storage is also crucial to preserve the quality and flavour of the mushrooms. Store them in a cool, dry place, and use them within a few days of harvesting.

After the demonstration of mushroom cultivation procedure, Prof M. V. Kale madam has congratulated student participants for successful completion of Workshop. 


